

Redwood City Public Library Art Exhibit Policy

Art Exhibit Policy:

GOAL

To provide a quality art display for continuing cultural exposure and to guarantee a place for community artists to display.

SELECTION

Art for display will be selected by a jury of three. One member will be appointed by the Library Board, one by the Sequoia Art Group, and one by the Civic Cultural Commission. If a member cannot attend a particular selection session, a substitute may represent him or her.

The Art Exhibit Jury of Selection will meet on an as-needed basis, but in most instances displays will be scheduled six months to one year in advance. Exhibits will be on display for two (2) month segments. The Sequoia Art Group will be responsible for the hanging and taking down of art pieces with the assistance of the library's facility aide.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Artists must live within the boundaries of the Sequoia Union High School District.

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMITTING ART

Artists are to submit no more than five (5) representative slides (in color if original is in color) with their name, phone number, address, and artistic medium and size. The top of each slide is to be identified.

Artists are to include a stamped, self-addressed envelope if return of the slides is requested.

Art must be easily wall-hung, such as paints, photographs, textiles, quilts, and drawings. When exhibited it must be mounted, framed or otherwise ready to hang.
